DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

All dogs must be identified by either Tattoo or Microchip

BABY PUPPY: For dogs of four and not exceeding six calendar months of age.

MINOR PUPPY: For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months

PUPPY: For dogs of nine and not exceeding twelve calendar months

JUNIOR : (Youth - Jugend) 12 - 18 Months

* Hip Scores are not required, however if a score has been granted it **MUST** be disclosed

YEARLING : (Young – Junghund) 18 - 24 Months

* Either a British Breed Survey Pass or Koerung is declared or if not yet attained, **Health tests relevant to a Survey / Koerung pass are required. Please bring health test confirmation to the show.**

All dogs over 12 months will be measured and required to pass a gun test

Breed Ring (Ring 1) – Judging of Baby puppy dog commences at 9.30am

Break for lunch after Puppy male approx 12.00am

Breed Ring (Ring 2) - Long Coats – Judging will commence at 10.00am followed by the Junior handling classes.

Breed Surveys (Ring 2) after lunch approx 1.00pm

Kennel Club Good Citizen Bronze Testing (Ring 3) 10.00am.

DIRECTIONS TO THE VENUE

Come off M1 at junction 9 on to the A5 towards Dunstable go to the main traffic lights in the centre of Dunstable and turn left. Carry on this road over 4 roundabouts up to the large double roundabout and take the A4146 sign post Leighton Buzzard . The venue is on this road past the church, down the hill on the right opposite Sparrowhall Farm.

For SATNAVS use LU6 2ES. The venue itself will be signposted off the A4146.

SUMMARY OF PUPPY/YOUNG DOG SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

(Based on WUSV rules and regulations)

1. The show is open to German Shepherd Dogs only
2. The show will be based on WUSV rules and regulations
3. The show will open at 8.00
4. Judging will commence at 9.30am
5. Entry fees must accompany the entry; on no accounts will entries be accepted without the appropriate fees.
6. The Club reserves the right to refuse entries
7. The judge's decision is final
8. Exhibitors are responsible for being in time for their classes.
9. The committee reserves the right to exclude any dog which they consider is not in a fit state for exhibition from disease or any other cause.
10. Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling his/her engagement, another judge will be appointed.
11. All handlers must wear a number bib whilst in the ring. The bib must be clearly visible. It is the dog OWNERS responsibility to ensure the bib is returned to the steward at the end of the class. Non returned bibs will be charged for at a cost of £10.
12. There will be a mandatory gun test for all dogs over 12 months of age.
13. All exhibits must have verifiable identification of either a tattoo number or ISO approved microchip.
14. All dogs over 12 months of age will be measured.
15. All exhibitors must collect their ring number from the IDENTIFICATION steward who will check the dogs tattoo number or microchip.
16. Teeth and testicles will be checked by the judge; only the bite will be looked at on the baby puppies.
17. All exhibitors must abide by all instructions from the judges, stewards and event organisers.
18. Cheques/ PO's to be made payable to The Southern GSD Group. The exhibitor will be liable for any costs incurred for dishonoured cheques.
19. In the event of the puppy/young dog show being cancelled, the club will refund any fees, less any reasonable expenses, to all exhibitors and provide a statement of costs where requested.
20. Dogs must not be left unattended in the precinct of the showground. Under no circumstances must they be tied up. See also Dogs in Cars section of schedule.

21. Exhibitors are responsible for the behaviour of their children and will be held responsible for any damage caused by them
22. Awards and critiques will be given out at the end of each class.
23. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL LATE ENTRIES BE ACCEPTED.
24. Please respect the venue and clear up after your dogs.
25. In the interest of safety, no running around the outside of the ring will be allowed, except in the designated areas provided. Please respect this rule and any stewards allocated to enforce this. If stewards are abused in any way you will be asked to leave the showground.
26. The use of remote trainers or pinch collars must not be used within the precinct of the show.
27. Exhibitors are obligated to make true statements about their dogs. Attempted deceptions may lead to disqualification of the owner and dogs from subsequent WUSV events held in the UK.
28. Exhibitors are obligated to show sportsmanlike behaviour.
29. The judge at puppy/young dog shows may not judge dogs bred or previously owned by them, partners or agents (Junior handling classes exempted).
30. From 1st January 2011 the Long Coated variety of German Shepherd Dog has been integrated into the WUSV system and can be shown in their own classes. WUSV rules will also apply to long coated GSDs and only standard colours are acceptable.
31. Each dog must be registered by the Kennel Club or relevant body i.e. SV or Irish Kennel Club etc.
32. All dogs on the showground must be free from illness or disease for the preceding 21 days.
33. All dogs entered, to the best of your knowledge, must not be disqualified under the Kennel Club, SV/WUSV or FCI Rules & regulations.
